The Survey

Transit Protection

- There are two coverage options for your possessions during a long-distance move.
 - **Full Protection:** This option is valued at \$10 multiplied by the weight of your shipment in pounds. This is a comprehensive protection plan for your possessions.
 - **Basic:** \$0.60/pound. A 32' TV would be covered up to \$33.

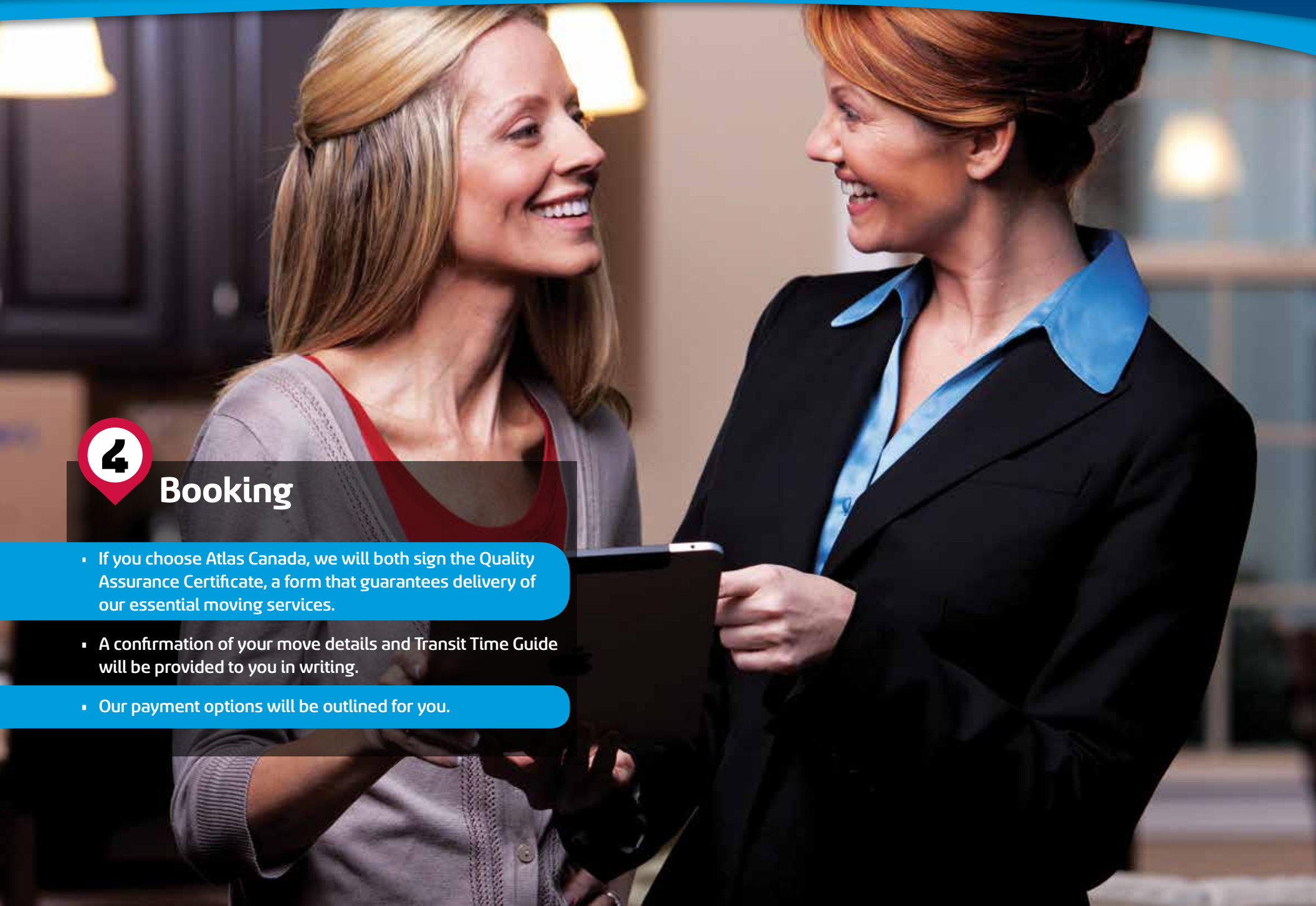

Packing

- Proper packing is essential to a successful move.

- If you choose to pack yourself, we can help you with packing tips and best practices. We can also provide you with the best materials at a reasonable cost.
- There are certain inadmissible items that cannot be taken on the moving truck and we can advise how to transport them safely.

Professional Van Operator

- Your Professional Van Operator (PVO) is a dedicated professional with years of moving experience.
- Your PVO is your Move Manager and will ensure the truck is loaded properly and safely.

Loading Day

- Your PVO will ensure your home is protected during the loading process: padding for banisters, floor runners, plastic wrap and blankets for furniture. Furniture that requires disassembly will be handled with care and packed safely.
- Your PVO will create a detailed inventory of your possessions.

Transit

- Once loaded, the Atlas truck will proceed to a government-inspected weigh station to ensure your estimated weight is accurate.
- Your possessions will make a long-distance journey in a special air-ride equipped Atlas Truck, specially designed to move household goods. This journey may include a few days in secure storage.
- Cross-Border Relocations: Your Moving Consultant will ensure you have all paperwork and understand all requirements prior to your move.

Delivery & Unpacking

- Your Professional Van Operator will contact you a minimum of 24 hours ahead of delivery to enable you to prepare for unloading your possessions in your new home.
- As the movers carefully unload your possessions, you can check off items on the inventory list and ensure all is in order.
- Carrier-packed items will be removed from cartons and placed in your home as directed.
- Packing material and debris will be removed upon completion.
